



How to Write Tibetan Letters

The table on the right shows how the Tibetan letters are drawn.

In general, the letters hang down from an imaginary line.

The lines are drawn from top down, from the left to the right.

Usually, the lines meet at certain points, and the lines make a sharp-like shape going downwards.

Consult existing Tibetan literature to see how the letters are drawn in various combinations. Note that the computer generated Tibetan letters are very clear and understandable, compared with various block-printed letters that might be sometimes hard to see.
